New Process for Verification of Emergency No Parking Signage

Step 1

Once a citizen receives and posts an Emergency No Parking Sign (ENP) they must immediately contact the Parking Enforcement Management Administration (PEMA) at **202-541-6083** and request a Parking Enforcement Officer to report to the location and verify that the (ENP) signs are posted.

Step 2

Upon arrival at the location, the Parking Enforcement Officer must **OBSERVE** that the sign is posted, and relay that information to **DPW's Customer Service/Dispatch Division**.

Step 3

DPW's Customer Service/Dispatch Division will record the verification of posted signage, and forward a list of verified signs to its Parking Enforcement Division.

Step 4

In the event that the signage is torn down before the 72 hour notice period expires, the citizen must immediately repost the Emergency No Parking Sign.

Step 5

After the 72 hour notice period has been fulfilled, the Parking Enforcement Officer will ticket all vehicles in violation, and request a tow from DPW's Towing Division.

Citizens may contact DPW at 202-541-6083 to request sign verification from Monday through Saturday.
